Minutes of regular meeting 1/10/24

Doug Gesel called the meeting to order at 12pm

MEETING REMARKS:

After the Pledge of Allegiance, a special thanks was given to all of the administrative assistants in attendance. The treasurer's report is on the website and was accepted by the membership.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: November meeting's minutes were emailed to Kevin Rank and will be available on the website shortly. September's minutes were accepted by the membership.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Kevin Rank posted the treasurer's report to the website and the report was accepted by the membership.

DELEGATE'S REPORT:

The September minutes are posted on the website. Rod Cameron, Dave Metzger, and Mike Fields attended the delegates meeting in Syracuse in December. There were issues at the ICC meeting with the award recognition for Chapter of the Year, it was done at a small chapter meeting instead of the general meeting as was done previously. NYSBOC's website has been updated and is currently online and functional. John Addario has put a Summary of Notable Changes to the 2021 and 2024 ICC Model Codes. It highlights the difference between the current code and the major code changes which are due next year. Almost half of all changes are new code additions rather than current code changes. NYSERDA is making changes to the energy code, so the energy code will not be updated at the same time as the rest of the code. Changes are being made to the CEDAR program and changes are being made for the yearly training to reflect the new code changes. Fossil fuels will be eliminated in new construction as part of the energy code changes. There are many bills

in the NYS Legislature that have a direct impact of code enforcement and code changes. The ICC is making changes to the code change process and there will not be any code hearings at the Orlando meeting. The ICC website has more information.
