MEETING REMARKS:

After the Pledge of Allegiance. The treasurer's report and secretary's report is on the website and was accepted by the membership.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Secretary's report was posted to the website and accepted by the membership.

TRESURER'S REPORT: Kevin Rank posted the treasurer's report to the website and the report was accepted by the membership.

DELEGATE'S REPORT:

Dave Burke is on the Events Association and Conferences committee and Dave Metzger is on the CEDAR committee for NYSBOC. It was suggested that building safety month be designated by the Governor. The NYSBOC website is working nicely, and there is a member's only section of the website. It is not open to the general public and shows what our lobbyists are working on. If you contact NYSBOC, you can get the login information to see what NYSBOC is in favor of or against. The delegates meeting notes are on the NFBOA website. We are working to get a new website available in order to remove code enforcement officers from SLMS so that the training is tracked separately. The window for comment on the Energy Storage Systems changes has already ended 3/5/24. Voting for ICC meetings can be remote now, and it is important for our individual departments to make sure we have someone that is able to vote on changes to building code as they are updated. There has been a push to make code enforcement officer public safety officers.
